SHOW RULES AND INFORMATION

- 1. NRHA Approved show. NRHA 2022 Rules & Regulations apply
- 2. Entries open 1.3.2022 and Entries close Wednesday 23rd March.2022
- 3. Entry online via SCRHA website. One Entry per horse. Link for entries will be sent out 23.2.2022
- 4. By way of making an entry and payment of entries you are assuming responsibility for and binding owner, rider and/or agent to the terms and conditions as set out.
- 5. Eligibility: (S) Sanctioned classes: Competitor is responsible for their eligibility/ Non Pro status for Non Pro classes.
- 6. Eligibility: (NS) Sanctioned classes: 2 Handed Rookie & Beginner Competitor is responsible for their eligibility.
- 7. By entering into the show the exhibitor and its associates accepts and agrees to abide by all rules and regulations, terms and conditions of the show. Any accident, injury, concern, complaint is to be directed and addressed to Show Management NOT the show office or SCRHA committee.
- 8. Show Management have authority to enforce all rules pertaining to the show and all decisions will be final. Show Management may excuse any horse, exhibitor and or its associates from the show. Unsportsmanlike behaviour will NOT be tolerated or accepted.
- 9. Show management reserves the right to alter and amend the program and prize money at their discretion and without notice.
- 10. SCRATCHINGS & SCRATCHING REFUNDS: HORSE or RIDER (Show Office to be notified of a scratching).
 - a) PRIOR SHOW: Where entry is in process by show office and prior the class draw being posted on website: No vet or Doctor certificate required, show office fee & judges fee retained, balance of class entry refunded
 - b) PRIOR SHOW: Where entry has been processed by show office and the class draw posted on website: Vet or Doctor Certificate to accompany scratching, show office, class entry fee & judges fee retained
 - c) AT SHOW: no refund granted. Exhibitors that scratch a class for any reason after the draw has been posted will be liable for any and all fees incurred in connection to entering that class. Refer NRHA 2021 Handbook
- 11. The working order will be drawn and run as per the posted draws. Exhibitors must report and be at marshalling area and be ready for their run. If a rider misses his/her turn as determined by the draw, he/she will be disqualified from that go round (except in unusual and unavoidable circumstances) Show Management will determine each case at its own merit
- 12. All Youth 13 years & under must wear Safety Helmets while competing and on the grounds.

- 13. SCRHA Class 1,2,4,5,7,9,12,19 **Non Sanctioned (NS) classes:** Non sanctioned classes are not subject to horse licensing requirements. NS classes do not require RA or NRHA membership.
- 14. SCRHA Ride N Slide Shootout Qualifying: 3 top scores + ties from Class 3A and B Green Reiner Levels 1 and 2, Class 9 Beginner Reiner & Class 12 Two Handed Rookie will advance to the Shootout Class 19. Riders will ride patterns as written, Green Reiner, Beginner Reiner, Two handed Rookie may ride pattern any handed in any legal bit.

 Shoot out to be ridden two handed with lead change as pattern description (simple lead change not permitted) in any legal bit
- 15. **Compulsory Media Fee**: \$10 is payable per run. Concurrent classes only pay one media fee. Exhibitors will be subject to the use of photographers and videographers under the direction of show management, Video & photography images may be used at the discretion of the Southern Cross Reining Horse Association for promotional purposes. Official Photographer / Official Videographer Paul Newport Video Productions.
- 16. Office Fee: \$75 is payable per horse per entry
- 17. Late & Additional Entry: Late Entry is deemed 'Late' when a horse entry that has not previously been entered is requested to be entered after the closing date of show entries. 'Late' entries will not be accepted after the closing date with the exception the 'late' entry request is in writing and addressed to show management, this request will be considered by Show management and if accepted by show management the horse entry will incur a late fee of \$25 in addition to all other entry fees applicable to the entry. Show Management reserve the right to accept or decline a 'late' entry.
 - 'Additional' entry will be accepted where the horse has previously been entered into the show, an 'additional' entry does not incur any additional fees to all other entry fees applicable to the entry. Additional entries will be accepted up to 4pm the day prior the event to be entered into.
- 18. **Concurrent class**: Horses that are entered in more than one class in a concurrent class will only have one run and the score will count for these classes. Only one **Judges fee** and one **Media Fee** is payable.
- 19. **Open Derby & Non Pro Derby:** For 5, 6, 7 and 8 year old horses. To be ridden one (1) handed in a bridle and any legal bit .Non Pro Derby entrants must enter the Level 4 class pus any other level they would like to enter.
- 20. **Open Futurity, Non Pro Futurity:** For **4** year old horses. Must be ridden one (1) handed in any legal bit . **Snaffle Bit Futurity** is for **3** yr old horses and must be ridden in a snafflebit 2 handed. Open Futurity Entrants must enter the Level 4 class plus any other level they would like to enter.
- 21. SCRHA Open Freestyle: Will be run in accordance with NRHA Handbook. SCRHA Show Management will reserve the right to rule on music or dress which may be inappropriate or offensive to the spirit and nature of the show. Show management may also determine the use of special effects. Class is not subject to horse licensing requirements. Song / Music title, length of song to be emailed through info@scrha.com.au when show entries have been submitted, show staff will arrange the song to be downloaded, do not provide cd's ipods, usb etc.
- 22. **Open Pen:** First half of each hour will be used for circles and spinning, the second half of each hour will be used for run downs. Do not stop and sit in the middle of the arena, move to the walls of the arena to rest your horse. exit arena when tractor enters.
- 23. SCRHA will retain 50% in all added money and between 20-50% in jackpot classes. Aged Payouts will be in accordance with the NRHA Handbook payback schedule B and

places will be awarded to 5th.

- 24. Ties, all ties for 1st place will be worked off if the tied exhibitors agree to participate in a run off. Tied exhibitors have the alternate option of agreeing not to run off and to be name co champions but must determine the winner of the awards by flip of a coin. If they do not agree the exhibitor (s) who does not want to run off will forfeit 1st place to the other(s). Ties that are worked off will use the same pattern and order of go as was used during the event, however there will not be more then 1 run off. If a tie occurs after the run off the entrance will be names co champions will evenly split first and second prize money but must determine the winner with a flip of the coin. In the event of a co championship the participant that loses the coin toss does have the option of purchasing a second trophy. Duplicate Buckles can be purchased direct with the Buckle Supplier. Show Office can provide details of the supplier.
- 25. Place awards and ribbons where tied will be determined by a coin toss. Prize money on the class will remain as scored
- 29: In the view of good sportsmanship and **as a mark of respect to the place getters** the SCRHA request that all competitors must attend class presentation and both horse and rider must be in appropriate western attire and horses saddled. You will not be allowed back in the arena for presentation if not complying.
- 30: Saddle prizes will be given in the form of a prize voucher from Bob's Custom saddles to the value of \$4200 USD dollars.
